World Enduro Championship 2005 – 7th round Finland

Metzeler pilots extend their leadership in all classes and there are only 2 races left.

Heinola, 27/28. August 2005 -The Finnish round welcomed the WEC riders with mixed, but mostly dry weather and four laps of a 46km beautiful located course, each day with 3 special test within each lap.

Enduro 1: Ivan Cervantes (KTM-Team) could extend his championship lead (+ 68 points) by winning both races. On Sunday you could see once more a complete Metzeler podium, which proves again the performance leadership of Metzeler tyres.

Enduro 2: On Saturday, on home soil, our Finnish rider Valtteri Salonen (Honda team) could reach his first victory of 2005. And also in this class Samuli Aro (KTM-Team) was able to extended his lead from + 51 up to + 68 points.

Enduro 3: On Saturday local hero Marko Takkala (KTM-Team) could beat for the first time in this season his invincible team mate David Knight, whereas on Sunday the Manxman could win with an lead of over 1:23 seconds.

The next WEC round will take place at Serres in Greece 28th/9th October, but before we will see the National teams fighting for victories at the FIM Six Days Enduro in Povazská Bystrica/Slovakia (13 – 18.09.2005).
